He is head of the Chair for Computer Graphics and also the founder and head of Computer Graphics - Engineering Animation Studies (at the Undergraduate, Master and Doctoral level of Academic Studies) since their establishment at the Faculty of Technical Sciences in 2011. He received his dipl. ing. degree (5 years study) in Mechanical Engineering in 1993 (at the Faculty of Technical Sciences), MSc degree in 1997 and PhD degree in 2000, both in Computer Graphics (Department of Computer Sciences at the Faculty of Sciences, University of Novi Sad, Serbia).
